The gifts will be delivered to Jeanes Hospital Opportunity Shop in Fox Chase, which benefits the Fox Chase Cancer Center located in Philadelphia, PA.
- When:** Thursday, January 10, 2008 @ 1p: Students preparing the gifts  
Friday, January 11, 2008 @ 2p: Students preparing the gifts for delivery
- Where:** 13550 Bustleton Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19116
- Why:** The “Re-Gifting” Program was conceived of by the Delaware Valley High School Student Council as a way to promote civic values among the students.
- Delaware Valley High School – Bustleton is one of the State’s leading alternative schools, providing individually tailored education programs to students with motivational and behavioral problems who have matriculated for “disruptive” conduct from over ten (10) local school districts, including Philadelphia, Centennial, Bristol Township, Central Bucks, Neshaminy, Bensalem, Bristol Borough, Morrisville and Pennsbury.*
