In reference to the lawsuits that we, the undersigned, filed against you captioned Cantor et. al. v. Shulick et. al., January Term 2003 No: 4212, and Cantor et. al. v. Shulick et. al., July Term 2002 No: 1742, we have agreed to withdraw our post trial motions in the January Term case and to settle the July Term action by paying you the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000) Dollars and terminating all of our claims against you and by exchanging general releases. We came to these decisions after having taken your deposition, and after further considering all the facts.

We, by signing below, sincerely apologize for our conduct, in both asking for your original malpractice fees to be reduced as part of the Ettin settlement, and further by bringing these lawsuits against you. We further recognize that the lawsuits filed on our behalf against you caused you significant expense, only part of which is reimbursed by this settlement, possible adverse effect on your future insurance coverage, and personal emotional distress.
